**Kitsap Children's Musical Theatre Scholarship**

Consistent with Kitsap Children's Musical Theatre (KCMT)'s mission *to train our KCMT youth today to become our community theatre leaders of tomorrow*, KCMT established a scholarship fund in memory of Michael Riedel in honor of his dedication and contributions to KCMT. A \$1000 merit-based scholarship will be awarded to one or more qualified applicants. Consideration will be given to the applicant's strengths in one or more of the following areas: KCMT participation, KCMT leadership, community service and leadership, other performing arts activities, other outside activities, and academics.

Preference will be given to first-time applicants.

**Eligibility:** Applications will be accepted from students who:

1. Have participated in a minimum of three KCMT productions , at least one of which took place during the applicant's high school years, and
2. Will be attending an accredited college, university, vocational school, or community college in the 2010-2011 school year.

**How to Apply:** Send the following to the KCMT Scholarship Committee:

1. A completed application form,
2. A letter of recommendation from a teacher, in a sealed envelope that is clearly marked with the student's name, and
3. A letter of recommendation (character reference) from a non-family adult outside of KCMT, in a sealed envelope that is clearly marked with the student's name.
